NUTRITION SERVICES REPORT

During the period under review, the Environmental Health Unit in collaboration with Dunkwa Health Directorate Nutrition Unit, teamed-up with the aim of ensuring the nutritional well-being of general public.


Good nutrition is crucial to the attainment of decent health, one's growth and development. Improved nutrition result is possible among concerned efforts by all stakeholders to holistically and sustainably address the problems that destabilize the gains made.

The following activities were performed to the year under review,

- Micronutrient supplementation
- Nutrition counselling
- Growth monitoring and promotion
- Management of severe acute malnutrition
- Training and supportive supervision.

Again, a total number of nine hundred and sixty-seven (967) School feeding caterers, food vendors as well as drinks sellers were sensitized and medically screened against typhoid, tuberculosis, hepatitis and so on.

A total of one hundred and twenty-two (122) School feeding contractors, School feeding caterers as well as food vendors and drink sellers were also trained during the period under review on food adulteration, food supplements, iodated salt, personal hygiene and so on.
